The Luftwaffe considers that the Battle of Britain went on into May 1941, rather than the RAF's 31st October 1940. German veterans claim they kept up pressure until withdrawn for the war on Russia. Our limiting date was set by Churchill's Defence Committee in 1943 and ends when invasion plans were abandoned. In a new book, John Foreman (Battle of Britain: the forgotten months) has more of a point in saying that Bomber and Coastal Commands' aircrew should have the BoB clasp for their part in preventing invasion.

The CAA will recruit 140 air traffic cadets in '89, compared with 30 in '87 and 80 in '88. Some ATC duties will in future be performed by support staff, and some busy control positions will be double-manned.

A simulator to train Air Traffic Controllers has been bought by Luton Airport for £24,000. Luton has 60,000 'runway' movements & 40,000 overflights/year, with +12% p.a.

Another bumper month for diversions, with some 22 aircraft finding Teesside more hospitable than elsewhere in the region, including a first visit by an AIR EUROPE aircraft and another B.757 of BRITISH AIRWAYS. AIR EUROPE, by the way, are finally to operate out of Teesside when they provide the aircraft for the Schools Abroad ski flights, starting in January.

Crew training also brought a surprise in the shape of AIR BRIDGE Merchantman (or Vanguard) joining the usual DAN-AIR and BRITISH AIRWAYS BAC One-elevens.

On the military front however, we scored absolute zero with not a single visitor, and none of the overshoots identified as yet. Perhaps some observant enthusiast managed to log a few at the end of '23'? In the event they were mainly Dominies and Jet Provosts - all the interesting items in the area now seem to go to Leeming.

Biz jets and biz props however were quite plentiful, including some fifteen from foreign registers. The German Falcon 50 on successive Sundays was perhaps the best. As reported last month by Albert, the appropriately-registered Trago Mills SAH.1 was inspected on 17/18th by Teesside Aero Club.

Sadly, BRITISH MIDLAND-leased B.737 'Tango Romeo' ended its association with both BMA and Teesside on the last day of the month, operating BMA338 from Heathrow before positioning to Luton. Its friendly crews had been part of our scene for some six months and were always a delight to listen to over the radio.
